

# Webster Breaks Pair of PIAA Records; Sprinter Budd Norristown, Morrisville Take Crowns Sets 2 Records, Villanova Wins

Coach Jack Armstrong's All-American boy Don Webster added two more records to his rapidly growing list in Saturday's 37th annual PIAA District One track and field championship meet at Norristown's Roosevelt Field.

The Kennett Consolidated High School senior posted new 100 and 220-yard standards, and seven records, in all, were broken as Norristown and Morrisville successfully defended their team championships.

### MISSSES THIRD RECORD

Webster also won his specialty, the 440, but missed by one-tenth of a second of equalling the mark of 0:48.0 he set last year.

Norristown's Class A victory came mostly on the strength of record performances by Bobby Mitchell and its mile relay team, along with a double victory by hurdler Larry Livers.

Mitchell, high jumping for the first time in competition, edged teammate Larry Brown to establish a new record of 6-4 1/2. Mitchell had not competed before because he had been on the Norristown baseball team, which completed its season Friday.

### MORGAN IS EAGLE STAR

Dave Morgan, running second leg, was the hero of the Eagles mile relay record run. Morgan took the baton from Jim Washington, trailing by ten yards, but handed it over to third man Livers 0:49.8 later leading by two. Henry Suber was the anchor in the 3:23.3 showing.

The other record to fall in Class A came when Harrison's Ken McCloskey kicked past John Bailey, Kennett, and Jim Murphy, North Penn, to win the mile in 4:27.7.

In Class B, Dick Hart, Morrisville, got off another one of his orbital shots to break his own shot put record. Dick's heave went 62 feet even, easily beating his throw of 60-10 1/4 last year.

## Fix Query Gets To Dayton Star

**DAYTON, Ohio, May 20 (UPI).**—Roger Brown, outstanding University of Dayton freshman basketball player, has been in New York City for questioning in connection with the basketball bribery scandals it was learned Saturday. Brown could not have been involved in any point-shaving because he did not play on the flyer varsity last season.

He was called as a voluntary witness, but an aide of New York District Attorney Frank Hogan, who is conducting the investigation, refused to comment. The university athletic department officials also refused to comment on Brown's appearance.

The 6-5 Brown was a standout high school player in Brooklyn, N. Y., before entering the university last fall. He was the top scorer of the flyer freshman team.

In New York, Lester V. Chalmers, North Carolina prosecutor in the scandals, confirmed that Louis Harshak, one of the "fix" suspects, is in the custody of the New York district attorney's office.

Chalmers came to New York to discuss the basketball bribes cases with representatives of Hogan. The North Carolina solicitor conferred Thursday with Alfred Scotti, Hogan's chief assistant.

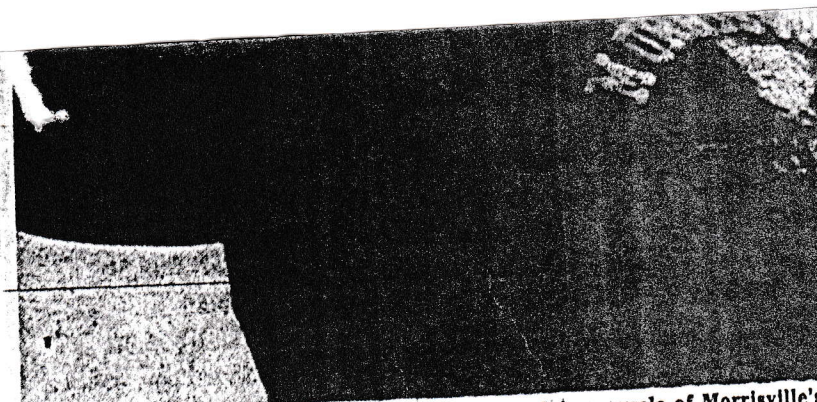

# Webster Breaks Pair of PIAA Records; Norristown, Morrisville Take Crowns

Coach Jack Armstrong's All-American boy Don Webster added two more records to his rapidly growing list in Saturday's 37th annual PIAA District One track and field championship meet at Norristown's Roosevelt Field.

The Kennett Consolidated High School senior posted new 100 and 220-yard standards, and seven records, in all, were broken as Norristown and Morrisville successfully defended their team championships.

## MISSES THIRD RECORD

Webster also won his specialty, the 440, but missed by one-tenth of a second of equalling the mark of 0:48.0 he set last year.

Norristown's Class A victory came mostly on the strength of record performances by Bobby Mitchell and its mile relay team, along with a double victory by hurdler Larry Livers.

Mitchell, high jumping for the first time in competition, edged teammate Larry Brown to establish a new record of 6-4½. Mitchell had not competed before because he had been on the Norristown baseball team, which completed its season Friday.

## MORGAN IS EAGLE STAR

Dave Morgan, running second leg, was the hero of the Eagles mile relay record run. Morgan took the baton from Jim Washington, trailing by ten yards, but handed it over to third man Livers 0:49.8 later leading by two. Henry Suber was the anchor in the 3:23.3 showing.

The other record to fall in Class A came when Harrington's Ken McCloskey kicked past John Bailey, Kennett, and Jim Murphy, North Penn, to win the mile in 4:27.7.

In Class B, Dick Hart, Morrisville, got off another one of his orbital shots to break his own shot put record. Dick's heave went 62 feet even, easily besting his throw of 60-10¼ last year.

## HURDLES MARK FALLS

Dick also won the discus with a 143-10 measurement to beat out teammate Vince Starszynski and lead Morrisville to the Class B title.

Bristol's Joe Pascale skimmed the 180-yard low hurdles in the record time of 0:19.7 to knock two-tenths of a second from that Class B standard.

Along with Webster, who won three events, and Livers and Hart, Upper Merion's Clarence Scott and Darby's Lionel Stephens were also double winners. SCOTT, STEPHENS WIN
