Lisa Thompson, Dawn Sowell and Charley James managed to outrun the weather.

Yesterday, that was saying a lot. The District One track championships were interrupted — and most athletes' efforts were severely hampered — by a downpour that stopped the meet for almost 90 minutes.

The terrible weather — rain accompanied by lightning at one point — may hurt district athletes further this week. Only the winner of an event automatically qualifies for the state championships, which will be held at Shippensburg State College on Friday and Saturday. To qualify for the state meet without winning a district first-place medal, an athlete must meet a state qualifying time.

Under usual circumstances, many more than district first-place finishers qualify. But yesterday's conditions denied many athletes the opportunity to meet the standard.

Despite the weather, Perkiomen Valley won team titles in boys and girls Class AA, Wissahickon won its second straight team title in boys AAA, and Pennridge won its first championship in girls Class AAA.

The portion of the meet run before the thunderstorm contained some of the best efforts in district history.

Thompson, a senior at Perkiomen Valley, won four events and set three records.

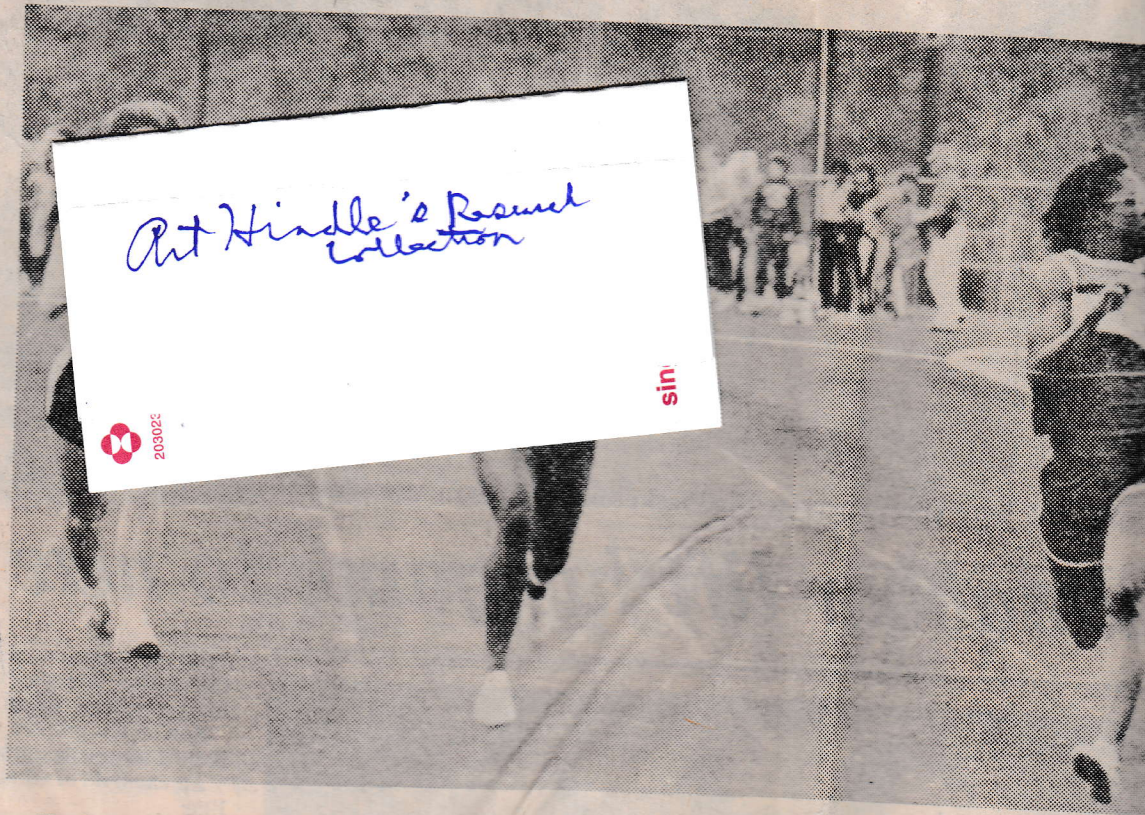
Sowell, a Chester junior, set a record in the 100 meters, won the 200 meters, and anchored the winning 1,600 relay team.

James, a Truman senior who is among the nation's premier hurdlers, won both his specialties and set a record.

Octorara's Andy Morlando won three events and anchored a winning relay team to bring his team close to Perkiomen Valley in boys AA.

But Thompson clearly was the class of the meet. She won the 100 hurdles in 14.95 seconds, the 100-meter dash in a record 12.22, the 300 hurdles in a record 44.11 and 200 dash in a record 25.02. The only record she did not break is one she already holds.

pushed Perkiomen Valley, one of the smallest schools in the district, to its fifth straight team championship in girls Class AA, and its sixth in seventh years.

The Vikings scored a huge total of 142 points, making second-place Swarthmore's very respectable 64 look tiny by comparison.

Perkiomen Valley's boys edged Octorara, 74-72, despite triumphs by Morlando in the 100, 200 and 400.

Sprinter Sowell appeared to be running by herself, despite the short length of her events. In the 100, her time of 11.58 not only beat the old mark of 11.70 (by Edyrl Parkinson of Cheltenham in 1981), but bettered the existing state-meet record of 12.03.

"In the semifinal, her times had ranged from 11.6 to 12.1," said Chester coach Jimmy Joyce. "They have to average those times out. (Three hand-held times are used in the meet).

"Before the final I told her it was time to cut loose and get a time they couldn't take away from her. Don't forget, that 11.58 was averaged, too. But we'll have to put up with that until they get electronic timers."

Sowell's efforts were not enough to push the Clippers to the Class AAA title they won last year. Pennridge, fueled by two firsts from France Childs, scored 54 points to win the team championship. Childs won the 100 hurdles in 14.73 and had won the long jump Friday afternoon.

Wissahickon repeated as the boys Class AAA champion, as Steve Smith and Courtney Holmes finished one-two in the 100-meter dash and led the winning 400 relay team. The Trojans scored 65 points, to 48 for Coatesville and 47 for North Penn, two other perennial powers.

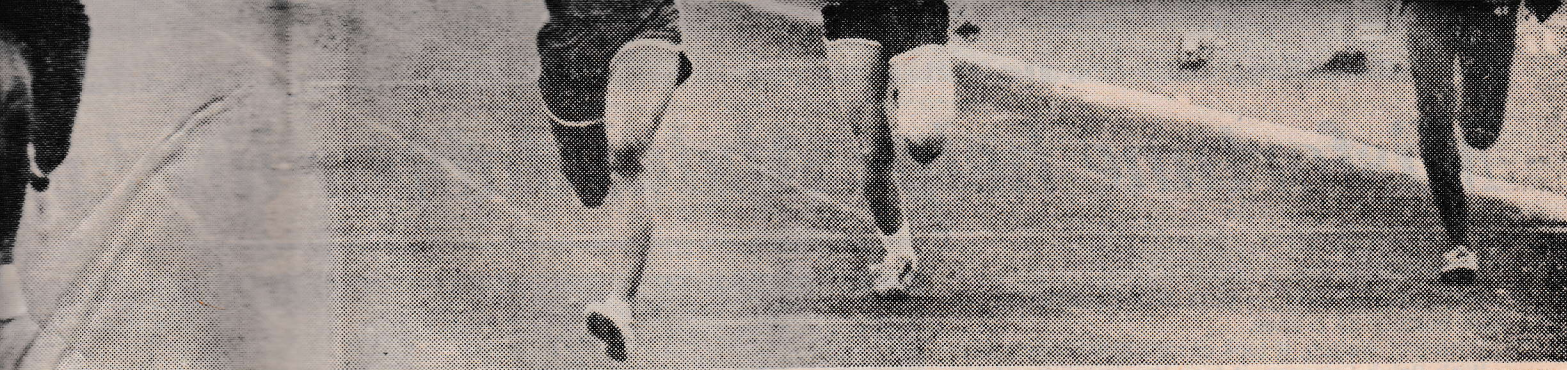
