

# for Merion Mercy star

It's much too early in her athletic career to compare Maisha Tyler to any world class athlete, but even her coaches at Merion Mercy Academy have told her she reminds them of Marion Jones.

Jones is the world champion in the 100 meters, while Tyler's top achievements so far are PIAA District 1 and state Class AA championships.

But similarities are apparent.

Tyler and Jones are both sprinters and long jumpers. Both play basketball, and they even wear their hair in the same short, curly style.

"My coaches have told me that," Tyler said of the similarities. Yesterday, Tyler made her own mark by repeating as the Class AA girls' long-jump champion with a leap of 18 feet, 8¾ inches at the first day of the District 1 championship meet at Coatesville High School.

That jump was more than a foot better than her winning jump last year.

Tyler, a 5-foot-10 junior, was the district champion in the 100, 200 and long jump last year and state champion in the 100 and long jump. Best of all, her coach says she hasn't reached her potential in the long jump.

"She's never been beaten," said Merion coach Jim Ryley. "She jumps as good as she has to. I want somebody to jump 19 feet against her."

Tyler also advanced to today's finals in both the 100 and 200, recording the best girls Class AA times in the trials. She'll also anchor Merion Mercy's 4x100 relay team in the final.

Finals were held in 14 field events yesterday, and one new meet record was set. Bishop Shanahan junior Nina Maillard won the shot put with a throw of 42-11½ in the girls' Class AAA event.

A surprise winner was Kelli Strickler of Pottsgrove. She won the girls' Class AAA high jump at 5-7 after clearing just 5-2 and finishing third at last weekend's Pioneer Conference championships.

In the Class AAA pole vault, Wissahickon's state indoor champion, J.C. Whittaker, hampered by a pulled hamstring in his right leg, jumped only the state qualifying height of 13-6. The event was won by Downingtown's Mike Castelein at 14-6.

The District 1 meet continues today. The state championship meet is Friday and next Saturday at Shippensburg University.

Keith Davis said he wanted to be the state indoor champion at 200 and 400 meters so badly that when he didn't win the 200, he decided he'd go after that double outdoors.

The Bensalem senior, the state indoor 400 champion and the national indoor 200 champion, won both Class AAA sprints during yesterday's PIAA District 1 championship meet at Coatesville High School.

Davis won the boys' Class AAA 200 in a meet-record 21.34 seconds and the 400 in 47.80.

"After I didn't win both at states, that's when I made up my mind," said Davis, who was the state outdoor champion in the 100 and 200 last year. "Winning at states is very important."

Davis missed the district 400 record of 47.63 when he raised his arms before he crossed the finish line, the same stunt that cost him first place in the 200 at the indoor state championships.

As impressive as Davis' double victory was, he had to share the spotlight with Coatesville's Keya Crutchfield, who blazed to first places in the girls' Class AAA 100 in 11.64 and 200 in a meet-record 23.85.

"I was very confident in the 100, and I just started liking the 200 this year," the Florida State-bound senior said. "I'm a little more cautious in it."

Crutchfield passed up indoor track to play basketball, but she's been dominant in the sprints since the outdoor season began in late March. Her times yesterday now rank her in the top three nationally in both sprints.

"It's high school," she said. "I feel I should do everything I can. High school is about getting good grades

and having fun."

One runner who had fun again was Merion Mercy junior Maisha Tyler, who added victories in the girls' Class AA 100 (12.73 seconds) and 200 (25.73) to the long jump she won on Friday. It was her second consecutive triple-victory performance in the district meet.

There were two Class AA boys' double winners: St. Pius X's Tom Parlapiano in the 1,600 (4:25.87) and 3,200 (9:36.00), and Lower Moreland's Jeff Rubenstein in the shot put (51 feet, 5½ inches) on Friday and discus (140-6) yesterday.
