

Perkiomen Valley high jumper had to wait out a rain delay before winning her event. 5/19-20/2000

It took Becky Bullard four years to win a district championship, and on the day she finally took home a first-place medal, her event took nearly four hours to complete.

Bullard, a Perkiomen Valley senior who is headed to the University of Illinois, has won medals at state championship meets in the high jump, 1,600 and 3,200 meters and has been a top-10 finisher in four straight state Class AAA cross-country championship races. But until she cleared 5 feet, 4 inches to win the Class AAA high jump at yesterday's District 1 track and field championship meet at Coatesville High School, she had never left a district or state meet with a first-place medal.

And after rain, thunder and lightning postponed the 9 a.m. start of the event and then forced another stoppage after it had started, it was afternoon before the event was completed.

"We were out here about 8:15 warming up and it started to rain hard, and we saw lightning. We said: 'Don't go near the goalposts,'" she said. "We left the field, came back, and it started to rain again, so we just left our stuff out there and went into the gym to warm up again."

When the high jumpers returned to the field, they were told the event would begin at five feet, rather than the normal 4-9.

"That's kind of high," Bullard said. "And there were puddles exactly where we run through, and that threw everybody off."

Only seven of the 18 entrants cleared five feet, and only Bullard and William Tennent's Tychelle Rudolph cleared 5-4. Both missed at 5-6, but since Bullard had no misses before that height, she won the event.

Bullard, who has competed in heptathlons in national AAU age-group

competitions, also advanced to this afternoon's finals in the 800 and 1,600 meters, and may also run the 3,200 this morning.

Girard College, one of the few Philadelphia city schools in the PIAA, had three individual winners in Class AA competition yesterday. Myra Dobey won the girls' long jump at 17-7, which would have been good enough for third place in the AAA event. Ron Cook won the boys' triple jump at 43-8¹/₄, and Tom Stuber won the shot put at 45-9¹/₂.

The only district meet record established yesterday was set by St. Pius X sophomore pole vaulter Marissa Dudek. Her 9-0 clearance broke her own year-old record by one foot.

The oldest boys' Class AAA district meet record is safe for another year. When Hatboro-Horsham's Brian Haupt won the discus throw at 175-3, he fell 8¹/₄ inches short of the district mark set by North Penn's Ervin Jaros in 1965. The only district record that has withstood more challenges is the Class AA boys' shot-put mark of 62-0 set by former Eagles offensive lineman Dick Hart when he attended Morrisville High in 1961. Stuber's winning put for Girard College yesterday fell more than 16 feet short of that.

But Tiffany Abney wasn't finished. She also won the 200 and 300 hurdles and anchored a relay victory.

On an afternoon too cold and damp for a late-spring track meet, Merion Mercy freshman Tiffany Abney stole the show at the District 1 track-and-field championships yesterday.

Abney broke a 20-year-old meet record while winning the girls' Class AAA 400 meters in 55.40 seconds. She also won the 200 in 24.54 and the 300 hurdles in 43.40, and ran a 55.9-second anchor leg to bring her team home first in the 4x400 relay in 3:56.46 — all in a span of two hours at Coatesville High School.

"I hoped to win them all," said Abney, whose father, Ken, runs the United Stars track program. "The four-by-four was the hardest because I had to catch my teammate."

That was Sierra McClellan, the Norristown junior who won the state Class AAA 400-meter championship two years ago.

Next week, at the state championship meet at Shippensburg, Abney, 15, will get a chance to face McClellan and another teammate, Dominique Darden of Harrisburg High, the winner of last year's state 400 as a freshman.

"I've beaten Dom," Abney said, "and she's beaten me as often."

While Abney's domination of the Class AAA events was the surprise of the district meet, there was no bigger upset than Radnor junior Adam Leive's winning the boys' 1,600 meters in 4:18.06.

All Leive did was beat Council Rock's Dan Coval, the state 3,200-meter and cross-country champion, and Neshaminy's Paul Hallman, the state indoor mile champion.

"I was trying just to go with the leaders," Leive said. "I had never been close to them before. I didn't think I'd do this good."

Coval finished third, behind Council Rock teammate Joe Wiegner, with Hallman fourth.

"He ran an impressive race," Hallman said of Leive, who made his winning move with 200 meters to go and won by two seconds.

The girls' 1,600-meter race offered no surprise. Pennridge's Renee Gunning won in 4:56.16 —

that qualified a full field from District 1 for next weekend's state championship meet. Weather conditions affected track times and field-event distances to such an extent that the number of district athletes competing in the state meet will be fewer than in several years.
