1 Time Schedule and Location:

 - 5:30 PM Round 1 Loser out At conclusion of first round, Round 2 may begin—Winners advance
- Friday, 2/2/18 @ Upper Dublin
 - Weigh-ins for all teams are at 5:00 PM
 - 6:00 PM Quarter Finals on 4 mats
 - 7:30 PM Semi-finals on 2 mats and Wrestle backs on two mats
- > Saturday, Feb. 3, 2018
 - 12 Noon Weigh-in AAA Consi round teams and AA Semi's
 - 1 PM AA Semi's and 2nd round Consi's
 - 2PM Weigh-in for Finalists
 - 3PM AAA Final , 3rd Place and AA Final

2 Qualifying to Tournament:

- ➤ (16) AAA schools will be seeded. Four (4) AA schools will be seeded. Participation in this tournament is voluntary.
- 3 <u>Seeding Procedure</u>: See Addendum in the back of the chapter.
- 4 Officials:
 - ➤ All officials will be paid by the District 1 Treasurer. Each official must sign the PIAA form with their Social Security number.
- 5 Timers and Scorers:
 - A timer and scorer will be required for each match..
- 6 Ticket Takers & Sellers:

One ticket sellers per location

- Per session with a max of two people.
- Please try to keep the number of ticket takers / sellers to a minimum.
- 7 Tournament Manager:

- 8 Steering Committee Tournament Supervisor:
- 9 <u>A Physician</u> must be present at each session. A certified Athletic Trainer should also be available. Any wrestler with a skin issue MUST have a note at beginning of weigh in. Final say of eligibility is onsite paid Doctor
- 10 <u>Police / Security</u> will be paid according to District / Municipal policy for the hosting school district. This must be approved by the tournament supervisor.
- 11 Refreshment cost must not exceed \$100.00.

12 <u>Complimentary tickets</u>:

Five (5) complimentary tickets will be issued to the participating schools to be picked up at the door or mailed to you by the District 1 office.

13 Passes:

- ➤ The following passes will be honored for all sessions:
 - District One Complimentary Passes
 - Wrestling Steering Committee Passes
 - Working Press Passes
 - College Recruiters & Wrestling Coaches with Credentials
- ➤ League Passes Will Not Be Honored

14 Tournament Program:

➤ The host site may prepare and sell tournament programs. Note: Include names of past champions and runner-ups in the program.

15 <u>Tie Breaking Procedures</u>:

➤ National Federation Rules book tiebreaker procedures will apply.

16 Broadcasting Fees:

- Educational Channels or school based radio / television broadcast No Fee.
- Commercial Radio \$50.00 per match
- Commercial Network or Cable Television \$200.00 / Entire Tournament or \$50.00 per session.

17 Awards:

- AA & AAA Team Trophies to the champions.
- AA & AAA 1st and 2nd place medals for the participants. 20 medals for each school.

Team with the lowest score will be ranked 1 to highest 4. Ties may exist at this time.

There will be discussions and votes to solve any issues with the first seeding.

The final vote of all league representatives will determine the seeding.


