Dear Colleagues,

Due to the state restrictions on the number of people permitted in indoor space, the Hershey Lodge will not be able to accommodate the 2021 53RD PSADA Conference on the scheduled dates of March 23-26, 2021. The PSADA Executive Council has rescheduled this year's Conference for Monday, May 24 through Thursday, May 27, 2021. This is a slight change to the normal format of Tuesday through Friday. The basic structure of the Conference will remain the same, events will just be one day earlier.

The membership survey completed this month indicated that 76% of those responding indicated they would attend a rescheduled conference in May. 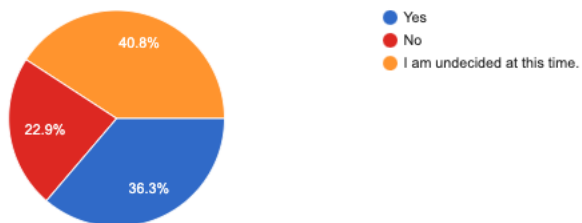

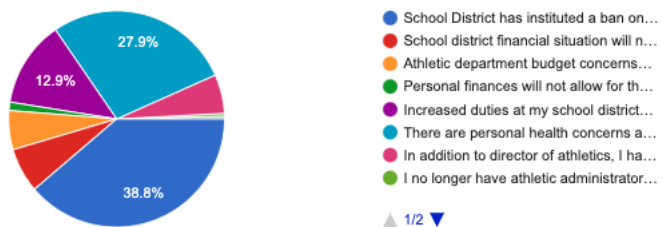
Are you planning to attend the 2021 PSADA Conference in March 2021?

If you were to decide not to attend the conference in March 2021, what would be your single primary reason?

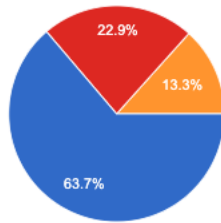

Has your school district implemented any type of travel or conference restrictions that effect your attendance at the conference?



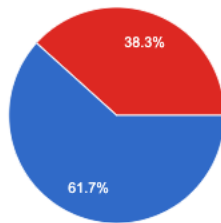

If it became necessary to provide the state conference online, would you attend a virtual offering?

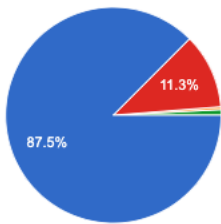

How many consecutive days should a virtual conference be offered?

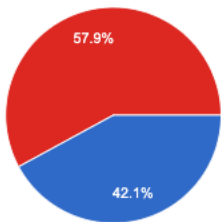

The state conference dates for 2021 are March 23 to 26 (Tuesday through Friday). From your perspective, what would be the best sequence of days within which to offer a virtual conference?

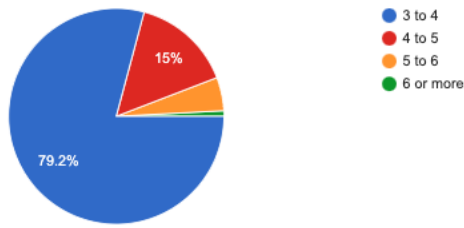

- Alter the dates to shortened schedule

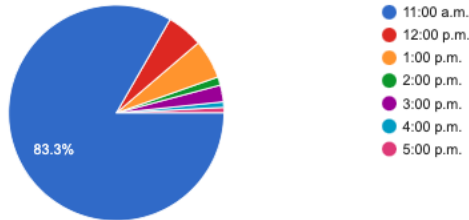
How many hours a day should a virtual version of the state conference be offered?

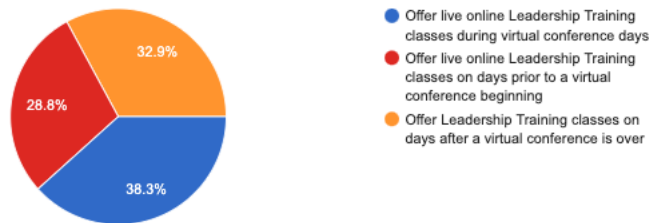
What time should a virtual conference begin each day?
