Pre-Tournament Details

- The tournament will start at 9:00 AM.
 - 2 mats will be set up in the gymnasium for all matches, with chairs on either side for teams.

- Teams may arrive at FCA starting at 7:00 AM; coaches and wrestlers only.
- Weigh-ins will be at 8:00 AM.
- Locker room/team room space will be available for all participating schools.
 - Bristol and Church Farm can head to our wrestling room.
 - Lower Moreland, PJP, and New Hope can head to our boys locker room.
 - Showers are available in our boys locker room.
- There will be a coaches room available in one of our classrooms for coaches to utilize throughout the tournament.
- Seeding will be announced by the PIAA by the end of this week.
- Coaches will need to provide line-ups by the end of the week.
 - Line-ups can be emailed to me and Head FCA Coach Ben Clymer.
 - Ben will be reaching out to coaches with further information, if necessary.
- Brackets will be updated throughout the day Saturday.
- Faith Christian will provide scorekeepers/table workers.
- District medals will be presented to each of the top 3 finishers in each weight class.
- Only official school personnel, coaches, and team members are permitted on or near the team benches. Parents and spectators are prohibited from sitting on team benches or stepping onto the mats prior to and during the tournament.
- Coaches attire: coaches are expected to wear appropriate attire while coaching on the mat. No jeans, t-shirts, or hats. Collared shirts are preferred.
- There will be a 5-10 minute intermission before the final round of bouts to honor Faith's 8 seniors. Once the senior recognitions have concluded, the final round will start. This has been approved by the District One office.

Tickets/Spectator Information

- Per PIAA Policy, tickets will be sold to all school aged children (age 5) and up.
- To purchase tickets, visit www.piaad1.org and select "Purchase D1 Playoff Tickets HOMETOWN TICKETS" on the right hand side of the website.
- The Hometown Ticketing App will be used to scan tickets at the gate as proof of purchase.
- Cash sales are accepted at the gate. All tickets are \$10.
- The following items are prohibited: artificial noisemakers (whistles, cowbells, etc.), unauthorized signs, balloons, and amplified portable listening devices. Any spectator who shows unruly, abusive, and/or unsportsmanlike behavior will be removed from the contest venue.
- There will be a concession stand in our cafeteria (across from our gym) with refreshments available for purchase during the tournament.
 - Coaches will receive a wristband for free concessions.
- Doors open for spectators at 8:15 AM.

Buses/Parking Information

- There are 2 entrances to our campus. The entrance at the front of the school, and a long driveway that leads to the back of the school, through Breisch Lane.
- It is best for the bus and officials to park in the back parking lot accessed through Breish Lane. Vehicles can remain parked in the lot for the duration of the game.
- Spectators can park in the front or back parking lot of the school.
