*Coaches Information

- During the wrestling competition (inside the ropes), D1 coaches are expected to wear appropriate attire while coaching on the mat. No jeans, shorts, T-shirts, or hats may be worn inside the ropes. Collared shirts and khakis are preferable.
- Coaches must have a **tournament issued lanyard with pass** to be on the competition floor and while inside the ropes.
- **Managers may not video from the corner.**
- Anyone entering the hospitality room must have a wristband including coaches.

*Wrestler's Attire

Wrestlers are required to wear school issued uniforms during competition, no club or college shirts or sweats. School issued uniforms/sweats are to be worn on the medal stand.

*Weigh-In

- **Doors will open for teams to enter at 7 a.m.** All teams must enter at the side entrance closest to the OAHS wrestling room.
- Saturday, 7:30 AM weigh-in and skin check (unofficial weight-check - 7 a.m. – 7:25 a.m.) Weigh-ins will be held in the OAHS wrestling room.
- Please have appropriate PIAA skin forms available at weigh-ins. Provide a copy to the head table
- Weigh-in/OPC sheets must be collected and presented to tournament director
- Head Coaches Meeting at 8:10 a.m.

*Entering Oxford Area High School

- When approaching OAHS from 5th Street onto Waterway Road proceed to the second entrance and go until you approach the side parking lot, once there, you will see two sets of double doors. **All teams must enter this location for weigh-ins. *Do not use the main entrance where the school sign is located. (If you are facing the building, go to the right side of the building.)***
- Teams will be asked to enter the building at the auxiliary gym/wrestling room throughout the tournament.
- **School vans should park in this lot as well.**
- **School buses should park as far away from the main building as possible.**
- **Do not enter the main cafeteria entrance during weigh-in times. You will be asked to walk around to the wrestling room doors.**
