

INFORMATION

WINNERS OF DISTRICT ONE TRACK & FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS

A. General

1. This District Track and Field Championship Meet is being conducted by the District Committee under the jurisdiction of the Board of Control, P.I.A.A. All contestants must meet P.I.A.A. eligibility rules. Events, conditions, etc., are governed by the National Federation of High Schools' rules.
2. Class A schools are those whose total enrollments (boys and girls) in grades 10 to 12, inclusive, on October 31, 1963, were 500 or more; Class B schools are those with enrollments under 500 in the same grades on the same date.
3. Participants in the District Meet must meet published minimum qualifying standards. Coaches are held responsible for entering in events only those boys who have met or, in the reasoned judgment of the coach, will, on the day of the District Meet, be able to meet, these standards. Failure to meet or adhere to these standards will result in warnings being sent to offending schools which, if not needed, could result in disbarment from future meets.
4. Should any boy whose name is not on the school entry list nor in the program compete in any event; should any boy not named on the school entry list nor in the program, use the name or number of a contestant whose name is in the program and on the school entry list, and complete in an event:
 - a) all points scored in the meet by the school from which the boy who is in violation comes, shall be cancelled;
 - b) all medals won in the meet by the school from which the boy who is in violation comes, shall be forfeited;
 - c) all entries from the school from which the boy who is in violation comes, for the State Meet, shall be disbarred;
 - d) the school from which the boy who is in violation comes, shall be disbarred from the District Meet the following year.
5. Two participants per school is the maximum permitted in all events except the relays.
6. No contestant may participate in more than three events, exclusive of the two-mile run. Participants in the two-mile run may not compete in any other event.
7. No post entries, changes in entry lists, or substitutions are allowed.
8. Five places will be scored in each event on a 5-4-3-2-1 basis. Gold, silver, and bronze medals will be awarded to the winners of first, second, third, fourth and fifth places in each event. Trophies will be presented to the school winning the highest total number of points in each class. Medals and trophies will be distributed to the winners from a stand erected on the field.
9. To keep the field clear of spectators and to have the meet run under proper conditions, athletes not competing in events will keep away from the track during track events and from the field during field events. There will be room in the stands and rest quarters for these people.
10. Coaches MUST remain in the stands.
11. The price of admission to spectators is \$1.00, including a copy of this program
12. Seeding for track events and the order of competition in field events were done before the meet.
13. The State Championship Track and Field Meet will be held at Pennsylvania State University on Saturday, May 22, 1965. The classification of schools and the rules for competition are the same as those governing the District Meets. Each of the twelve districts in the Commonwealth may send two teams, Class A and Class B. Each team will be made up of two representatives in each event. In preparing the entry blank for the State Meet, the District Committee will select the contestants that finish first and second in the various events unless notification is given by successful contestants that they cannot participate in the State Meet. In such cases the Committee will select winners of third, fourth and fifth places in order. A relay team will be considered as a "representative" or "contestant." This procedure will be followed in making up both the Class A and Class B District teams.
14. Athletes qualifying for the State Meet must be reported by their coaches to Mr. J. Lewis, Chairman of the Track Committee, concerning their decision to take part in the State Meet, IMMEDIATELY after the event. The costs of

contestants to the State Meet will be borne by the District Committee. Mr. Lewis will be in charge of the District One teams on the trip and at the Meet. Mr. Ream will act as financial representative of the District Committee for the State Meet. Contestants may not travel to or from the State Meet in private cars without having obtained permission from Mr. Lewis. Such permission is required for athletes to be permitted to represent District One in the State Meet.

15. If an athlete is competing in the trials (100, 220, both hurdle races) he may pass his trials in field events (if entered) but he must report for these events within three minutes after completion of the trials and remain at the site of the field event(s).

B. Track Events

1. Minimum qualifying standards for track events:

No standards have been set as yet by the Track and District Committees for the two new events — the two-mile run, the two-mile relay. However, coaches shall enter only those boys in these events whose performances will compare favorably with those of other contestants.

2. The preliminaries will begin at 10:00 A.M. (Daylight Time). Track finals will begin at 2:00 P.M. (Daylight Time). The District Committee desires the meet to be run off without unnecessary delays. Contestants will therefore report promptly for their respective events.

3. There will be no semi-finals in either track or field events. Trial heats will be necessary in some events, but in the 440, 880, the mile, the two mile, and all three relays, only finals will be held. If there are too many contestants for one heat in these events, two or more heats, or sections, will be run against time, each main place winner being timed. The first five place winners will be determined by their time performance.

4. In the 180-Yard Low Hurdles, the first hurdle shall be placed 20 yards from the start and the remaining hurdles at 20-yard intervals. The distance from the last hurdle to the finish shall be 20 yards.

5. In the 120-Yard High Hurdles, 10 hurdles, 39 inches high, will be used. The first hurdle is 15 yards from the starting line. Each of the hurdles will be 10 yards apart, leaving 15 yards between the last hurdle and the finish line.

6. In all finals of running events, the time of both first and second places shall be taken and recorded.

7. In the half-mile relays for Classes A and B, each contestant shall run 220 yards. In the one-mile relays for Classes A and B, each contestant shall run one quarter of the mile. In the two-mile relay for Classes A and B, each contestant shall run one half of a mile.

8. Both first and second place relay teams in Class A and Class B will be taken to the State Meet by the District. Both first and second place relay teams, in Class A and Class B, will receive the same financial support from the District as any first and second place winners in other events.

9. Claims for National and District records in sprint events and hurdle events, will be accepted only when information about wind velocities can be furnished. A wind gauge will be used in these events in District Meets. A wind velocity of less than 4.473 miles per hour favoring the runner is required for an application to receive favorable consideration.

C. Field Events

1. Minimum qualifying standards for field events:

No standards have been set as yet by the Track and District Committees for the Triple Jump. However, coaches shall enter only those boys in these events whose performances will compare favorably with those of other contestants.

2. In the field events, no entries are permitted after the first round.

3. In all field events, a contestant shall be charged with an unsuccessful attempt if he does not complete his trial or indicate his passing it, within TWO MINUTES after he has been called for a trial.

4. In the field events (shot put, discus throw, javelin throw, long jump and triple jump), every contestant will be allowed four trials. The six best will qualify for the finals with three trials each.

5. For District and State Championship Meets, in the event of ties, points and places will be decided according to Section 2, Rule 5, of the National Alliance Edition of Track and Field Rules.

6. The weights of the shot used in P.I.A.A. meets shall be 12 pounds. The discus and Javelin shall conform to N.C.A.A. standards. Shot and disci used in this meet are those belonging to the District Committee. Javelins must be weighed in and inspected before the event by the officials in charge of implement inspection.

7. At Norristown, hard surfaces are used for jumping events, shot and disci soled shoes with pin spikes will be permitted — no others!

8. Coaches and winners in the shot put, discus throw, high jump, long jump, triple jump, pole vault, will note that at the State Championship Meet the surfaces will be hard surfaced. No spikes will be permitted on the shot and discus circles. Rubber-soled shoes must be worn in these events.

9. The high jump starts at five feet four inches for Class B and five feet six inches for Class A. The bar will be raised by two-inch intervals to six feet; by one-inch intervals above six feet. Three misses at any one height will disqualify a contestant.

10. The Class B pole vault will start at ten feet. The bar will be raised by six-inch intervals to eleven feet, by four-inch intervals above eleven feet; by two-inch intervals above twelve feet. Up to eleven feet, a total of three misses for ALL heights will disqualify a contestant. From eleven feet on, a total of three misses at any one height will disqualify a contestant.

11. The Class A pole vault will start at eleven feet. The bar will be raised six inches to eleven feet six inches, then by three-inch intervals to twelve feet; by two-inch intervals above twelve feet. A total of three misses in the first three heights will disqualify a contestant. From twelve feet and above, a total of three misses at any one height will disqualify a contestant.

12. If weather conditions require it, changes in starting and interval heights will be decided upon at the beginning of the meet.



Ellis, Jaros Shatter Records In PIAA District 1 Track Meet

Abington and Swarthmore, led by Doug Tolley's triple, captured class titles and five records were shattered yesterday in the Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association (PIAA) District 1 track and field championships at Norristown.

Bob Bryant won both the 220 and 440 to spark Abington to its second straight Class A crown, the Ghosts rolling up 53½ points to runner-up North Penn's 38½. Swarthmore dethroned Media as the Class B kingpin as Tolley copped the 440, 880 and one mile runs.

Derby-Colwyn won the final Class B event, the one-mile relay, to come within 3 points of tying Swarthmore, which had its runners win six events.

Abington's 880-yard relay team, composed of Bill Wilson, Ron Holt, Rich Steen and Ron Reid, established one of the five new meet standards. The quartet lowered the Class A record for the event to 1:30.2, bettering the former mark set by Pennsbury in 1960 by two-tenths of a second.

North Penn's Erv Jaros and Greg Ellis, of Lansdowne-Aldan, considered two of the best weight men in the state, didn't disappoint their fans. Both set records.

Jaros threw the discuss 175 feet, 11½ inches, a distance which easily erased the 13-year old record of Norristown's Charley Brockson of 161 feet, 10¼ inches.

Ellis made up for his Penn Relays' defeat at the hands of Jaros in the shot put by tossing the platter 60 feet, 5¾ inches. The former mark was 58 feet, 2¾ inches by Lower Merion's Burt Grossman, also in 1952. Jaros finished second with 57½.

Frank Lacey, of Pottstown, and Bob James, of Pottsgrove, accounted for the other new records. Lacey improved upon his own Class A one-mile run mark when he was timed in 4:26.5, clipping eight-tenths of a second off last year's record.
