

Avon Grove High girl snaps disc

Janell McMillan made the best throw of her life yesterday in shattering the PIAA District One Class AA girls' meet record in the discus.

When the Avon Grove High senior tossed the discus 116-3 feet at Delaware Valley College, she broke the mark of 103-8 set by Lower Moreland's Sharon Mitnik in 1977.

"I didn't expect to win by this much,"

McMillan said. "Last year, I only won with a 100-foot throw. I thought it would be a lot harder this time."

McMillan has been throwing the discus only two years. Her best previous effort was 112-0 in a dual meet. She started out throwing 80 feet, then hit the 90s, but her big improvement came when she learned the spin technique.

"I started to throw further with the spin," McMillan said. "It's not a tough move. I

started out doing the power throw. Then my coach, Mr. (Keith) Maurer, taught me how to do the spin. Now the discus goes a lot further."

Today, McMillan will compete in the high jump and the triple jump, trying to qualify in those events for the PIAA championships next weekend in Shippensburg.

"She's an extremely strong girl and, in the two throwing events (discus and javelin), her size and strength of arm and the leverage she has is really a benefit to her," Maurer said.

3 girls set meet records in wet District I opener

Three girls set meet records at the rain-swept opening day of the PIAA District 1 track championships yesterday.

Unionville's Candy Cashell set a record in the Class AAA long jump, Avon Grove's Janel McMillan set one in the Class AA discus and Perkiomen Valley's Tammi Paton broke her own one-year-old record in the shot put.

Only 12 finals, all field events, were held yesterday. The bulk of the championships will be held when the meet resumes at 9 a.m. today at Delaware Valley College in Doylestown.

McMillan had a great day, finishing fourth in the shot put to Paton's record effort, after having shattered the discus record in the morning. She threw the disc 116 feet, 3 inches, to break the record by nearly 13 feet, Sharon Mittnik of Lower Moreland had set the previous record, 103 8 1/4, in 1977. The state record is a monstrous 136 0 by Peri Radecid of Brentwood, also set in 1977.

Paton broke her own shotput record by exactly 2 feet, putting the shot 24 5 1/4 yesterday. The state record is 42 6, set by Kathy Travers of Wilmington High, in last year's state final.

Cashell high-jumped 5 7 to break the record by 1 inch. Gina Deans of Pennridge had set the previous record in 1978. William Tennent's Lois Haizenheller also jumped 5 6 yesterday, in what would have been a record-tying effort on any other day.

Pauette Wellington of Wissahickon missed the Class AAA long-jump record by 1/4 inch, winning the event with a leap of 18 6 1/4. The district record, set by Conestoga's Missy Helak in 1977, is 18 7.

One record-holder, Jake Howard of Methacton, didn't have the same



Sydnor cracks 100, 200 marks in championships

Chris Sydnor breaks track records with amazing regularity.

At the PIAA District One track championships yesterday, Sydnor took aim at the 100 and 200-meter records and smashed them into submission.

Sydnor, a Radnor senior headed for Penn State, clocked :10.31 in the 100 meters breaking the standard of :10.724 he set last year. Sydnor got off to a quick start and was never headed.

In the 200 meters Sydnor accelerated near the 120 mark to explode to a :21.42. That broke his old mark of :22.27 set in 1979.

"I felt really strong," Sydnor said. "I was picking up speed as I ran. I knew I had to blow it out early because there was so many good guys in the race. I did what I had to do."

North Penn took its second straight Class AAA team title outpointing Chester, 74-48. Darby Township won its first Class AA District title since 1978.

The most spectacular race of the day came when Boyertown High junior Creighton Rothenberger caught North Penn's Blair Mancini in the stretch to win the 1600-meter run in 4:21.4.

Mancini had taken the lead in the early moments of the last lap.

"I wanted to stay with the pace and then kick in down the straightaway," Rothenberger said. "I was in second and third position the whole way. I didn't race against him (Mancini) last year. I raced him at the indoor states when he got second and I took fourth at Lehigh.

"I knew about him this year," Mancini's conqueror said. "You can't just have him on your mind, you must watch everybody. I knew everybody would be tough. When he took the lead, I just wanted to stay near the top contenders. I was going to depend on my kick today. My plan was to stay close, then open up."

Mancini, who is suffering from strained leg tendons, placed second in the 1600 meters in 4:22.15. In the 800 meters he clocked a 1:54.40, breaking the record of 1:54.41 set by Dave Long, Ridley, 1979.

"I was a little mad at myself for the mile," Mancini said. "I wanted to win this one."

Plymouth-Whitemarsh's Rob Irvine, headed for LaSalle College, won the 110 high hurdles in :13.99, the 300 intermediate hurdles in :37.3 and ran a split on the 3200-meter relay

"It's my legs... they just take me where I want to go. What I try to do is catch the person on the outside of me by the first hurdle. In the league (Suburban One) meet I caught the person at the second hurdle. Today I didn't catch anybody until the fifth hurdle. That really messed me up."

In class AAA, North Penn (Dave Schmitz, Dan Travis, John Hradnansky and Mancini (1:59.9 split) won the 3200-meter relay in 7:59.5. Ridley, with Aubrey Moat anchoring, won the 1600 meters in 3:19.43, breaking its 1980 record of 3:20.59.

In Class AA, Darby Township (Monte Cooper, Gene Walls, Charles Mason and Roger Johnson) won the 400-meter relay in :44.41. The Eagles' Kevin Young took the 1600-meter run in 4:31.9.

3 girls set meet records in wet District I opener

Three girls set meet records at the rain-shortened opening day of the PIAA District 1 track championships yesterday.

Unionville's Candy Cashell set a record in the Class AAA long jump, Avon Grove's Janell McMillan set one in the Class AA discus and Perkiomen Valley's Tammi Paton broke her own one-year-old record in the shot put.

Only 12 finals, all field events, were held yesterday. The bulk of the championships will be held when the meet resumes at 9 a.m. today at Delaware Valley College in Doylestown.

Today's events will include the boys' Class AA long jump, which was washed out along with several qualifying events by yesterday's downpour.

McMillan had a great day, finishing fourth in the shot put to Paton's record effort, after having shattered the discus record in the morning. She threw the disc 116 feet, 3 inches, to break the record by nearly 13 feet. Sharon Mitnik of Lower Moreland had set the previous record, 103-8 1/4, in 1977. The state record is a monstrous 136-0 by Peri Radecoff of Brentwood, also set in 1977.

Paton broke her own shot-put record by exactly 2 feet, putting the shot 34-5 1/4 yesterday. The state record is 43-6, set by Kathy Travers of Wilmington High, in last year's state final.

Cashell high-jumped 5-7 to break the record by 1 inch. Gina Bearn of Pennridge had set the previous record in 1978. William Tennent's Lois Hatzenbeller also jumped 5-6 yesterday, in what would have been a record-tieing effort on any other day.

Paulette Wellington of Wissahickon missed the Class AAA long-jump record by 1/4 inch, winning the event with a leap of 18-6 1/4. The district record, set by Conestoga's Missy Helak in 1977, is 18-7.

One record-holder, Jake Howard of Methacton, didn't have the same

great outing that had carried him to the district and state marks a year ago. Howard set the state record by long-jumping 24-3 last year, but he managed only 22-8 1/2 yesterday. He finished second to Dave Wells of Chester, who leaped 22-10 1/4.
