

# Penn Wood girls, W.C. Henderson

## Grube not enough for Upper Darby

It was a typically hectic day for Upper Darby's Rebecca Grube, whom one rival coach termed the "finest all-round girls' athlete I've ever seen."

The junior won the 300-meter hurdles yesterday at the District 1 Track and Field Championships at West Chester University's Farrell Stadium. She also won the long jump, was fourth in the 100-meter hurdles and finished far back in the triple jump.

"I like to keep busy," said Grube, who also is a swimmer, diver and gymnast for Upper Darby.

She couldn't, however, keep busy enough to put the Royals' girls' team in contention for the AAA district title. That was won by Penn Wood, which received first-place finish from D'Angela Johnson in the 100 meters and triumphed in the 400-meter relay to finish with 62 points.

Penn Wood's margin of 14 points over second-place Truman should have been larger, but its 1,600-meter relay team was disqualified for using foul language after its victory. Cheltenham, the second-place team, was awarded the victory in the race.

West Chester Henderson was third in the standings with 43 points.

In girls' AA competition, Avon Grove compiled 108 points to take first place. The Red Devils' Tolanda Cain won the long jump and the 100 and 200 meters, and was a member of the winning 400-meter relay team.

Gwynedd-Mercy was second with 67 points, and Pottstown third with 62.






